# KATHY'S KOMMENTS

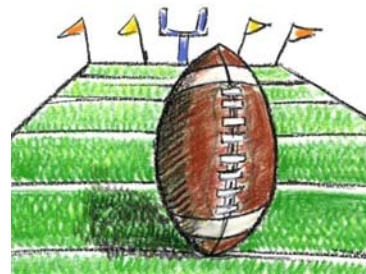
Welcome, September!! The first day of fall is September 22<sup>nd</sup>; it will be here before we know it.
