Hope you have a Happy St. Patrick's Day! I'm sure Jo will brew you up something green!

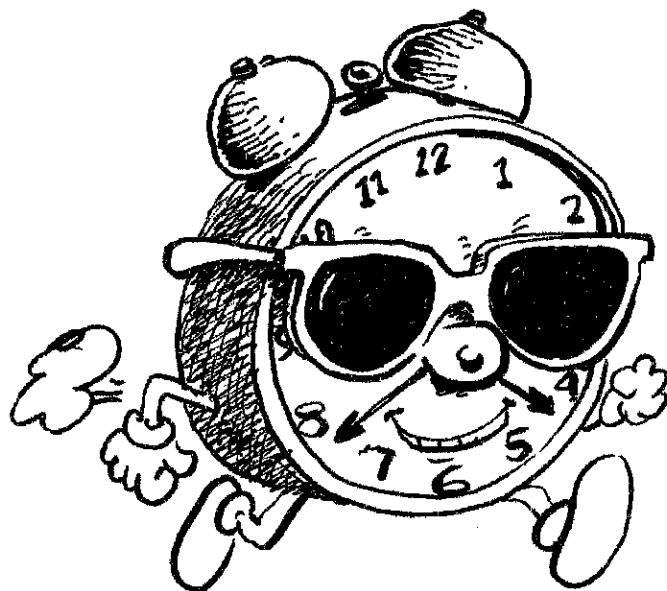
